Seller Checklist

- Read through the instructions carefully. Even if you are a return-seller, there are new guidelines and instructions on preparing your items for sale.
 Register online @ www.twiceblessedsale.org
 Sign up for delivery appointment using the sale system.
 - Delivery dates: 9/11/2023 and 9/12/2023
 - *We cannot accept items without an appointment.
 *Drop-offs are processed by appointment time.
 - *Text/Email ASAP if you are not able to make your appointment. **419-202-5777**

- Prepare and enter all items according to instructions.
 *Limit of 200 items.
 - *Finish entering items by Midnight Saturday, Sept 9th
- □ Sign up to volunteer! Twice Blessed is staffed 100% by volunteers. Volunteering is not required but great volunteers, like you, make the sale successful!

IMPORTANT REMINDERS:

System Shutdown

System will close at <u>Midnight on SATURDAY, SEPT 9th</u>! Sellers will NOT be able to make any changes to inventory after this time.

Item Pick Up

All items not donated must be picked up on **Saturday**, **Sept 16st from 2:30-3:00 pm**. Please do not arrive before 2:30.

Seller Checks:

All seller checks will be sent by mail. You'll be asked to verify your address while registering for the sale.

Consignment Sale System:

- *Registration, volunteer sign-up, inventory management, and printing tags all online.
- Off-Season items: Due to space limitations, we cannot accept off-season items – swimsuits, tank tops, sleeveless shirts, shorts, sandals, etc.
- QUALITY: Our volunteers will check over each item at drop-off.
 Everyone has items turned away because of undetected stains, wear/tear, or broken parts, please don't take this personally.

Instructions and Guidelines

A. CONSIGNMENT FEES & SETTLEMENT OF PROCEEDS:

- A \$6 Seller Registration Fee & 30% commission will be deducted from your proceeds. Twice Blessed 30% commission is for our Church's Children's Projects, with 10% donated to outside charities.
- Checks will be mailed
- Your itemized sales report can be viewed online.

B. ITEMS ACCEPTED:

- Children's clothing: sized Infant newborn ~ Junior girls/Young Men boys
- Maternity: clothes, nursing tops, bras, etc.
- Outerwear: Shoes, Boots, Jackets, Coats, Snow Gear
- Toys for all age groups, bikes, sports/athletic equipment
- Books, games, DVDs, puzzles: All video/computer games rated 10Y and under only. Children's DVDs (G and PG only).
- Nursery items: cribs, nursery decorations, baby furniture, crib bedding
- Baby Gear: strollers, current car seats, playpens, high chairs, jumpers, etc.
- Other baby items: feeding, bath, potty training, travel, safety, etc.
- Other children's items: Children's furniture, bedding, themed bedroom décor, etc.

BRING THE "BIGGER KID" STUFF TOO!

C. ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED:

- Adult clothing other than maternity wear.
- Clothes that are dirty, missing buttons/hooks, have holes/stains, excessive wear/tear.
- Stuffed animals (unless it's an action toy like Chicken Dance Elmo, or something similar.
- ALL ELECTRONIC TOYS MUST HAVE WORKING BATTERIES this allows shoppers to see that they work!
- VHS Tapes
- Off-season items (for example: swimsuits, tank tops, sleeveless shirts, shorts) will not be accepted for this Fall sale save it for our Spring sale in April!
- Car Seats or baby gear that has expired. Please refer to the manufacturers' label on your car seat for exp. date.
- Any other item that would NOT be used for children (general home décor, movies/games for adults, other furniture, accessories, etc.).

Twice Blessed has a strong commitment to keeping the quality of our sale high. We want people to continue shopping and participating in our sale for many years to come. Our volunteers try their very best to ensure the items we sell are of high quality, in good condition, and clean! Attention to quality and proper preparation of your items will make our sale prosper and your consignment experience better.

D. PRICING YOUR ITEMS:

Twice Blessed wants you to have a successful, profitable sale. We suggest you use these pricing tips from what we've learned. Remember, there are other sellers competing for sales, presentation and pricing can make all the difference!

- . We suggest to price items at 1/3 of what the item can be purchased as new.
- We highly recommend that you opt YES, to reduce prices 50% on Saturday.
- Prices must be in 50¢ increments

TIP: We have found clothing items priced \$5 or less and/or clothing put together as complete outfits sell very quickly.

E. PREPARING YOUR ITEMS:

INVENTORY SHEET & TAGS: EVERYTHING

MUST BE DONE ONLINE!

- Online: Go to our website (www.twiceblessedsale.org) for the link to register as a seller. Once registered, you can return to the
 "Seller Homepage" at any time to create/edit your inventory sheet (it will be saved online for you!) and print your tags.
 - **The system will close at Midnight, Saturday, Sept 9th. After that, no changes can be made.**
- Item Description: Make it DETAILED so if your item loses its tag, we can try to match your item back to your list.
 (Ex: Instead of "shirt" write "Green shirt w/ dragon print." Or instead of "book," include a portion of the book's title.)
- For clothing sizes/categories: When the size isn't marked on your clothing, make your best guess. Be sure to select the correct
 category or it may be racked incorrectly and won't sell!
- Half Price Day: If you want an item to be half price on Saturday,
 CLICK ON THE BOX NEXT TO "CHECK TO DISCOUNT" FOR EACH ITEM TO BE REDUCED.
 - If you do not click this, your item will not be reduced by our system and can only be sold full price.
- Donations: Checkmark the box next to the word "Donate" for each item you wish to donate if it does not sell. Be careful to not
 checkmark items you want back. All items marked "Donate" are given to a local charity directly after the sale closes.

CLOTHES - ALL CLOTHING ITEMS MUST BE ON HANGERS - SEE DIAGRAM BELOW

- Launder and sort your clothes. Iron them if necessary The nicer they look, the better they sell!
- All shirts, pants, shorts, need to be on hangers. Secure pants to top of hanger, within a few inches of the hook with large safety
 pins, so they don't slide. Please, no plastic hangers on items larger than 2T (they break w/ bigger items on the rack).
- Multiple pieces: On outfits with more than one piece, safety pin all items together so they do not get separated. On top & bottom
 outfits, safety pin pants/skirts on the hanger, outside of the back of the shirt, not under.
- Tagging your clothes: Safety pin tags to the SHOULDER of garment, or PANT LEG, <u>SEE ILLUSTRATIONS BELOW</u>,
 (**Raincoats: Attach tags with clear packing tape. Don't make holes with safety pins.**)
- Hanger hook should be turned away from the tag (as shown) so tags are easily visible when customers are sifting through a rack.
 As you are hanging your clothes, think of a question mark (?) That's the direction the hook should be open to.





WHEN YOU ARE FINISHED WITH YOUR HANGER ITEM, IT SHOULD LOOK LIKE THE DRAWING ABOVE.

Clothing items prepared incorrectly will have to be corrected before we can accept them.

LARGE ITEMS:

- Clean all items, then secure tags in a clearly visible spot on the item using packing tape, or safety pin if there's fabric.
- If there are small pieces with a large item, place them in a Ziploc bag and secure the bag to the large item using packing tape – please no scotch tape!

Toy Tips: Write on the tag that the toys or game is complete.

PLEASE MAKE SURE ALL

PIECES ARE INCLUDED AND

THE TOY IS IN GOOD

WORKING CONDITION.



ALL OTHER:

- Clean your items and attach tag securely.
- Small items: Use zip lock bags for
 - Socks
 - o Underwear
 - Small Shoes

Small toys (Legos, etc.)

o Other Small Misc. Items

- Hair accessories
- Small Games
- Use clear packing tape to tape tags on OUTSIDE of zip lock bags. Staple or clear tape them shut so they can't be opened at the sale.
- Large Shoes: Fasten together, either with the shoe strings, string or cable ties.
- BATTERY OPERATED TOYS: <u>MUST HAVE</u> WORKING BATTERIES TO BE ACCEPTED AT DELIVERY TIME. We cannot accept
 toys that don't work. We cannot supply batteries, please bring your own.
- Sheet and blanket sets: Safety pin, tie, or (clear) bag pieces together. Make sure your tag is secured and can be easily found!! If bagging, attach the tag to the OUTSIDE of the bag.
- Books: **Please tape sale tag OVER any visible barcode** For individual books, use removable tape or rubber bands to secure the
 tag so not to damage the book. For multiple books, place in a large ziplock and tape the tag to the OUTSIDE.
- Puzzles: Saran Wrap works great to keep puzzle pieces in place!

F. LOST ITEMS TABLE

Any item without a tag that could not be matched to a consignor, will be placed on the LOST ITEMS TABLE
 *Please check that table during the sale, in case one of your items may be there.

*Items left will be donated, after Saturday pick up.
